- Being a blood donor for those needing the "gift of life"
- Participating in the food packing event and donating funds that provided 50,000 meals to families in Baja, Haiti, Tanzania, and San Diego
- Serving dinner to single parent families in transition from homelessness to a safe and secure future through Solutions for Change
- Building condos at the Habitat building site in Logan Heights and working at the ReStore shop in Escondido
- Our youth groups have also been busy serving food to the homeless, helping with some of the previously mentioned activities, and spreading the gospel through drama and conversation during their mission trips

We are so fortunate to have Richard, Frances, and Isaiah Lin traveling to Mongolia as RB Community Church representatives at the 25th Anniversary of CRU International bringing the word of God to first generation Christian teachers. It's amazing and rewarding to know that we have had a hand in spreading the love of Jesus around the world through CRU, Talking Bibles, Transkei Ministries in Africa, Middle Eastern Ministries, and Walindwa in Kenya.

Did you know that RB Community Church funds flowing through the Mission Committee and the Deacons support 32 missions and 8 missionaries? Starting in July, this cover article on missions will begin highlighting them, so more of us are aware of the good work these folks do on our behalf.

There is a lot going on at RB Community Church and I would like to invite you to become active in the new Mission Ministry starting in July 2018.
